What personal data is collected from members?

When you apply to become a member of the Moray Firth Partnership, we ask you to provide your name, address, telephone number and email address.

How will your email address be used and handled?

We use your personal data to manage the membership of the Moray Firth Partnership – e.g. to determine your eligibility to vote at the AGM – and may use your contact details to keep you informed of the activities of the Moray Firth Partnership. Paper copies of membership application forms are filed in our office. Members' personal data is also included in our membership database, which is held on a secure server.

Why can we do this?

We process the personal data of our members to further the legitimate interests of the Moray Firth Partnership – in particular, to ensure the smooth running of the Partnership in accordance with our Memorandum and Articles of Association and to keep supporters informed of the activities of the Partnership.

Other data

This Privacy Notice only applies to data collected for managing your membership of the Moray Firth Partnership. We may hold other data about you (if, for example you have
